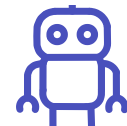
The Skills That Matter Most

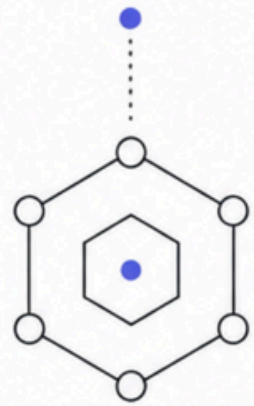

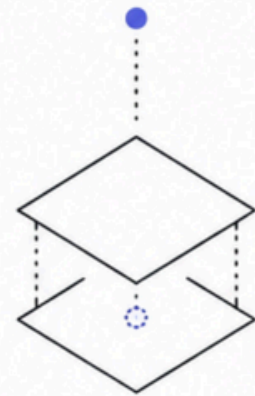

What Is a Community?

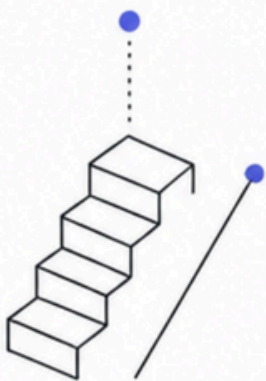
A community is more than a group of people — it's a **living ecosystem** where shared interests become shared growth.



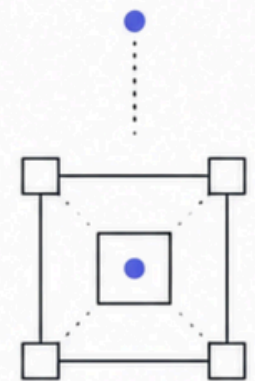
